

## ***Frequently asked Questions about Trick or Treat Trail.***

### ***What is a Trick or Treat Trail?***

Belvedere House provides Trick or Treat Trails each Hallowe'en Bank Holiday on the estate. There are three different Trails, Under 5 in Cherry Valley, close by the Jealous Wall, Under 10 Start point at the Lakeside Arena towards Gazebo. Over 10 Start point at Lake Shore and along Earls Trail. These Trails and a large part of the estate have been seeded with Hallowe'en novelties and sweets. There are none in Belvedere House or the Walled Garden.

### ***What Time does it start?***

All trails start at 12-midday. Be on site at 11.30 to allow time to get to your trail starting point. There is only one start time it is not an all day event.

### ***Any other advice?***

Check weather conditions for the day and dress appropriately for an outdoor activity. Make sure you pick up a map at Reception to find your way back .

The Reception at Belvedere Visitor Centre is the meeting point for lost parents and for the children that out ran them. Let your child know that. Belvedere number (044) 9349060 is on the map.

We encourage you to instruct your children not to grab all they can as other children will miss out. The Belvedere Yeti will be in the Woods and doesn't like greedy children or parents.

### ***What other events are on that day?***

The Forest of Fear begins at 1pm. It consists of a Tram ride through the Woods where the Yeti and his Horrible friends lurk.

This costs €2 per person and is a 15 minute trip. There is no pre-booking just a queuing area.
